## from the July Board meeting

Began discussion of how to improve 2-way communication with the membership. Example of the problem is ordering 35 dinners for Changing of the Guard dinner and only 26 people attended. Newsletter, emails, and sign-ups at meetings are not working. There will be a member survey to gather input.

Potential fundraising events are a sheephead tournament open to the public, hosting a food truck rally.

Probable social activities include a pizza party, a play and a fish fry.

Expand the education mini-grants to include the private schools in the three communities. Distribute information in September.
