Nov 8 MMSD = Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewage District

MMSD is a regional government agency that provides water reclamation and flood management services for about 1.1 million people in 28 communities in the Greater Milwaukee Area. Protecting public health and the drinking water supply, MMSD is highly regarded nationally as a leader in wastewater treatment, flood management, and green infrastructure. A recipient of the U.S. Water Prize and many other awards, we are most proud of our record of 98.5%, since 1994, for capturing and cleaning wastewater in a 423 square mile area.

Milorganite, manufactured by MMSD since 1926, is one of the nation's oldest recycling efforts. MMSD captures wastewater using large-scale processes that mimic nature. Microbes digest the nutrients found in the water. The cleaned water is returned to Lake Michigan and the microbes are kiln-dried into small pellets. Milorganite is actually a bag of dried microbes (not poop)! Milorganite stands for "**Milwaukee Organic Nitrogen**".
