Flight to end Polio

John Ockenfels and Peter Teahen's Flight to End Polio took three months to circumnavigate the globe.

As the two men made their plans, they added a fundraising component to the trip. "Humanitarian and charitable works are a big part of our lives," says Teahen. "So we decided to make the flight to eradicate polio." To encourage donations, the men made it clear from the start that they would pay for the trip (which ultimately cost about \$100,000). All money raised to end polio would go directly to The Rotary Foundation, where every dollar donated would be matched by a two-dollar contribution from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.



Over the next 12 weeks, N732WP would make 37 stops in 19 countries. There would be tough times — Ockenfels spent several days flying solo while Teahen recovered in hospital from a nasty intestinal ailment — and tense moments: an electrical failure over the Pacific (which was repaired after a 90-minute return flight to Brisbane, Australia) and an encounter with a squadron of armed soldiers when the plane arrived in Karachi, Pakistan.
