
PolioPlus

Over the past nearly 40 years Rotary International has contributed \$2.1 BILLION to eradicate polio, with an additional \$100 BILLION contributed by governments across the globe. We have created a support system that has improved sanitation, healthy living, medical facilities, and educational opportunities in countries that formerly had very limited resources. That is the "Plus" in PolioPlus. This work has wiped out Polio in 99.99967% of the world.

If we stop now, in 10 years there are expected to be over

200,000 new cases of polio globally. We are on the final mile of making polio extinct. Only smallpox has been eliminated as a disease. There is no cure for polio, only prevention. Stopping the spread now will mean thousands of kids will never be exposed.

Rotary made a promise to the children of the world in 1985, that we would eliminate polio and make them all safe.
