RI President-elect Stephanie Urchick says members create the magic with every project completed, every dollar donated, and every new member of Rotary.



Rotary International President-elect Stephanie Urchick announced that the 2024-25 presidential theme is *The Magic of Rotary* and called on members to recognize and amplify the organization's power to save lives.

"Don't misunderstand me – we are not going to end polio or bring peace to the world by waving a wand and saying some funny words," Urchick told incoming district governors at the Rotary International Assembly on 8 January. Urchick urged members to champion Rotary's Action Plan, find a balance between continuity and change, and work for peace. She underscored the necessity of balancing continuity and change, both of which animate Rotary's Action Plan.

In addition to emphasizing peacebuilding, Urchick reiterated Rotary's commitment to eradicating polio. She urged the incoming governors to join or initiate PolioPlus Societies in their districts and do all they can to help end the disease.

"The plan is all about building on our best ideas, not abandoning them," Urchick said. "We face a tough balancing act. We must change ourselves and stay true to who we are."
