Forest bathing, also known as forest therapy, started in 1982 as part of a national campaign in Japan that promoted visiting forests as a way to reduce work-related stress. The concept was called shinrin-yoku (yes, it translates as "forest bathing" or "bathing in the forest atmosphere").

Scientific research into the practice of forest bathing is confirming "what we have always known innately" about a walk in the woods: that it has real benefits for physical and mental well-being.
