

Aid for earthquake affected communities in Turkey

Since the earthquake and aftershocks in February 2023, Rotary has distributed over US\$4 million to support affected communities. Aid efforts were confined to Turkey since Rotary has no clubs in Syria.

The immediate aid included a search-and-rescue van, hospital supplies, tents, sleeping bags, and air conditioners. Since then, members have assembled container cities for housing, built water treatment plants, provided seedlings and cows to farmers, given equipment to hospitals, donated computers for students, operated a mobile dental clinic, provided machines that farmers could share to harvest potatoes and make silage. and opened a veterinary clinic.
