We really can eliminate a cancer

HPV (human papillomavirus) is a highly common sexually transmitted infection that can cause six kinds of cancer, including cervical cancer. Caught early, cervical cancer is treatable. But more than that, it's preventable. In 2006, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration approved the first HPV vaccine, which could be administered starting at age 9.
