Hurricanes Helene and Milton relief efforts

Hurricane Milton made landfall on 9 October in Florida. Mere weeks before, Hurricane Helene battered areas in and around the Eastern Seaboard. Storm surges and heavy rains produced extreme flooding throughout the region.

"We reached out to a few clubs in the area and compiled a list of needs. We completely stuffed the 12' x 7' truck with supplies," says Jeff Davis, the club's president." A club member drove the truck to a supply drop-off site in North Carolina. The club is also raising money to buy generators. In Florida, members are helping to remove sodden drywall and flooring from flood-damaged houses.

The Rotary Club of Dunedin North, Florida, rented a 26-foot moving truck and filled it with shovels, rakes, cases of water, garbage bags, and utility knives to cut up and remove wet carpet. The club has set up four distribution centers where people can get supplies.

"We have multiple clubs going to homes, mucking out and gutting these houses. Drywall has to be cut out as high as the water line, and all flooring has to be cut out," Middleton says.

The Rotary Foundation has awarded three \$25,000 Disaster Response Grants to provide food, medication and supplies to areas affected by the hurricanes.
