Dogs are feeling especially lucky in the Yukon territory thanks to the Rotary Club of Whitehorse-Rendezvous, which bakes, packages, and sells pet treats to raise funds. Proceeds benefit the Mae Bachur Animal Shelter and the Food Bank Society of the Yukon in Whitehorse. Past President Rumsey's mother created the recipe, which includes pumpkin and peanut butter. "We always sell out," Rumsey adds. "We even deliver to people's homes."

In December, the Rotary E-Club of Greece began delivering wheelchairs to archeological sites and museums throughout the country. Benefiting institutions included the Aegean Maritime Museum on Mykonos, the Archaeological Museum of Patras, the ESIEPIN Press Museum, and the Museum of Cycladic Art. "This is a large-scale project covering almost all of Greece, with deliveries planned for 14 museums and archeological sites," says George Stavropoulos, immediate past president of the e-club.
