Rotary recipe of the month: Shrimp po' boy

INGREDIENTS

2 French bread sandwich rolls
2 tablespoons of softened butter
1/3 cup of mayonnaise
2 teaspoons of Creole seasoning
1/2 pound of shrimp, cleaned and tails removed
1/4 teaspoon of garlic
Salt and pepper to taste
Shredded lettuce
Sliced tomatoes

DIRECTIONS

1. Slice bread rolls open and butter the insides with 1 tablespoon of butter. Toast at a low temperature for three-to-four minutes.
2. Stir together the mayonnaise and Cajun seasoning and set aside.
3. Preheat a small skillet over medium-high heat. Add the remaining butter to the skillet. When it starts to sizzle, add the shrimp and garlic. Add a pinch of salt and pepper. After one minute, stir the shrimp and let them cook on the other side for another one-to-two minutes. Do not overcook. When done, add the lemon juice and stir.
4. To each side of the bread, spread the mayonnaise mixture. Top with lettuce, shrimp, and tomatoes. Serve hot.
