### Rotary Community Corps

A Rotary Community Corps (RCC) is a group of non-Rotarians who share our commitment to changing the world through service projects.

RCC members plan and carry out projects in their communities in collaboration with local Rotary clubs. Sponsored by a Rotary club, an RCC leverages Rotary's network, brand, and mentorship by partnering with clubs to plan and implement service projects.

RCCs increase Rotary's impact and expand its reach by bringing the knowledge and talents of local people to strengthen their community through sustainable projects.

There are more than 12,000 corps in 105 countries and 257 districts.

- 12,903 RCCs were active during the 2022-23 Rotary year.
- 54% of RCCs are in urban areas and 46% are in rural areas.
- 79% of RCCs meet at least once a month.
- 36% of RCC members are 40-50 years of age, 30% are 30-40 years of age, 18% are 50 and older, and 17% of RCC members are 18-30 years of age.
- 43% of RCCs have predominantly female members, 36% predominantly male members, and 21% equal number of female and male members.
- Club presidents characterized RCC members 68% are committed to service but are not qualified for membership in a club 54% are qualified for membership in a Rotary club but are not interested in joining.
