NIGERIAN GRANT

In early 2024, Rotary magazine reported on a major initiative aimed at reducing high maternal death rate in Nigeria. Together for Healthy Families received a \$2 million Rotary Programs of Scale grant to increase the availability of high-quality maternal health services and promote the r use. The program implemented in three Nigerian states and the Federal Capital Territory with the hope that it would be expanded.

Now the data is in for the first two years t— they had trained 1,146 health workers in emergency obstetric and neonatal care, respectful maternity care, data entry, and community outreach. Workers conducted nearly 26,000 home visits and led community dialogues that reached more than 36,000 people. Birthrates at health care facilities supported by the program increased by up to 35%.
