Larry Lunsford, President-Nominee for 2027-2028

Larry A. Lunsford, a certified public accountant and a member of the Rotary Club of Kansas City-Plaza, Mo., was confirmed Sept 15 as president-nominee of Rotary International — the association of the membership service organization's 45,000 clubs worldwide — and will begin his one-year term on July 1, 2027. Lunsford is a member of Rotary since 1991.

From fighting disease to supporting education — Rotary members work toward building the optimal conditions for more peaceful and resilient societies. "Our greatest strength lies in our ability to unite people of all cultures and generations through a shared commitment to doing good. We exist without borders and boundaries, and we see each other as part of our collective Rotary family "

Lunsford will also oversee Rotary's top goal of ending polio. Alongside its Global Polio Eradication Initiative partners, Rotary has achieved a 99.9 percent reduction in polio cases, and contributed more than US\$2.9 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect more than 3 billion children from this paralyzing disease.

Born and raised in Macon, Mo., Lunsford attended Truman State University. He first encountered Rotary when he received an Ambassadorial Scholarship to spend the 1981-82 academic year in Australia.
