Nigerian takes office as president of Rotary International

Olayinka Hakeem Babalola, a member of the Rotary Club of Trans Amadi, Nigeria, took office as president of Rotary International on 1 July 2026, becoming the second African to lead the global membership organization.

During his term, Babalola will focus on strengthening Rotary's contribution to peacebuilding and supporting sustainable, community-led solutions that address local and global challenges and improve lives.
