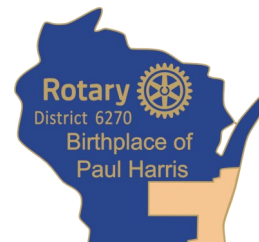

Rotary International Convention

Rotary announced Barcelona as the host of its annual international convention, to be held 2–6 June 2029 at the world-class Fira de Barcelona venue. This is the second time the RI Convention will be held in Barcelona.

Often described by attendees as a “mini-United Nations,” the RI Convention brings together participants from more than 140 countries for plenary sessions, workshops, an exhibition of humanitarian projects, and cultural and networking events.

The five-day event will welcome up to 20,000 participants from more than 140 countries and generate an estimated €68 million for the local economy.
