\*Brief discussion about changing the club meeting day to Wednesday. Survey will be sent to the members.

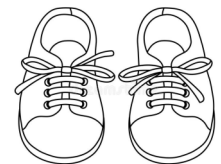
\*5 volunteers for school supplies/ shoes voucher distribution July 31
