Below are some answers to frequently asked questions about club membership.

How do I become a ROTARIAN?

What qualifies someone to join Rotary? A prospective members must be persons who demonstrates good character, integrity, and leadership; possess good reputation within their business, profession and/or community; and are willing to serve in their community and/or around the world.

How does an individual become a Rotarian? To join, you must have a sponsor. Your sponsor will invite you to a breakfast meeting where you can meet other Rotarians and experience a Rotary meeting. Your sponsor will explain the application process and refer you to a pre-induction mentor.

Where does Rotary meet? The Rotary Club of Rohnert Park-Cotati meets each Tuesday morning at the Sonoma Wine Country Doubletree Hotel, 1 Doubletree Drive, Rohnert Park. The meeting is a breakfast from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM. Occasionally we will meet offsite at another location. Please check our meetings calendar at www.rotaryrpc.org.

What are the current financial obligations of belonging to the Rotary Club of Rohnert Park-Cotati? (Rotary Fiscal Year: July 1—June 30)

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Admission Fee:	One-time only (member materials – pin, badge, shirts, banner, etc.)	\$100.00

Are there minimum attendance requirements? To remain in good standing, you must be engaged as a member. Generally, you should participate in 60% of a total of the club activities (meetings, socials, projects, events, & fundraisers). Meetings missed are easy to make up. Attendance at regularly scheduled committee meetings, board meetings, new member orientations, Club social functions all count as a meeting make-up. Additionally, you can make-up a missed meeting by attending other Rotary Club meetings anywhere in the world or even online.

What is the New Membership process? Your Sponsor will ask you to complete a prospective Member Application and return it. The Application will be submitted to the Board for consideration. Upon approval, you will be notified immediately. As soon as scheduling allows, you will be introduced to the Club by your sponsor during a regular club meeting. At this meeting, you will receive your name badge and introductory materials.

Is there a New Member Orientation? The Rotary Club of Rohnert Park-Cotati is committed to help new members find their place in the Rotary World, availing all aspects of service to better the world around us. Your sponsor or a member of our membership team will provide you a one-to-one New Member Orientation at a mutually agreeable time and place. At our earliest opportunity, we will also invite our newest members to a Fireside Chat, where club leaders and senior members of the club will discuss in greater detail all aspects of Rotary and help you find your service passion.

Are prospective members ever turned down? Prospective members can be turned down because the Membership Committee or the Board of the Club feels that he/she does not meet the qualification for membership.
