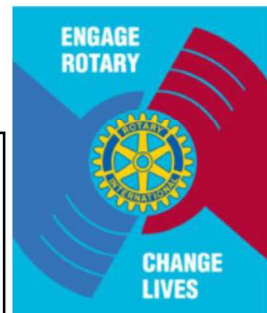

He quoted RI President Ron Burton, who said in Lisbon this year:

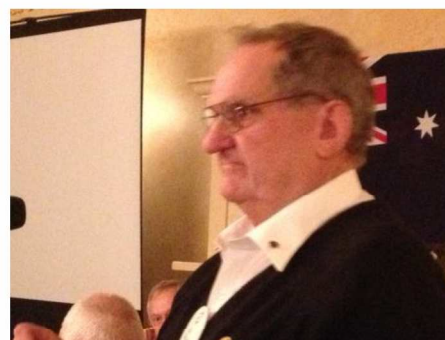
