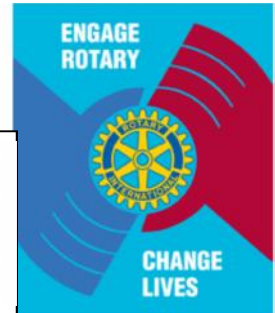

Project 1

Cycle, jog or walk between the stations then undertake strengthening exercises at each station in a circuit.

Project 2

Before district amalgamation there were two RYLA programs each year. One metro and one in the SW - catering for between 80 and 90 participants in total.

Since amalgamation there is just one program catering for less than 40.

Project 2 is to re establish the SW RYLA for January 2016.

Project 3
