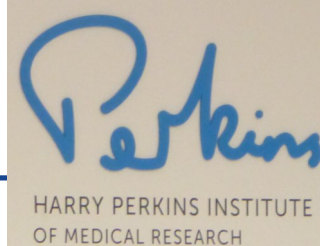

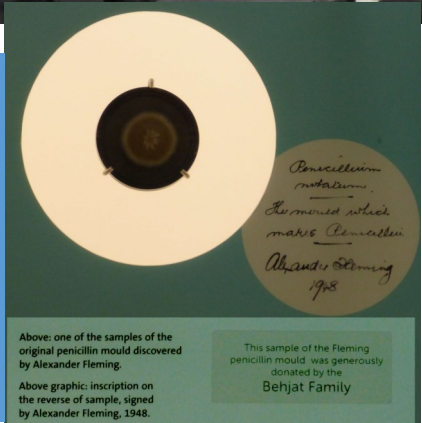

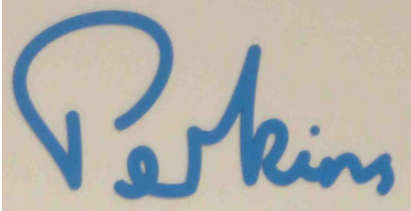

The Institute was opened by Tony Abbott on March 11 2014.

The premises are located in a 10 storey building within the Queen Elizabeth II Medical Centre.

The construction cost of \$122 million came from: Federal Govt \$65m, State Govt \$25m, UWA \$25m, Lotterywest \$5.4m, McCusker Charitable Foundation \$1.5m.

The Institutes focus is on: Cancer, Cardiovascular Diseases, Diabetes and Neuromuscular Disease.

Co-located researchers: UWA, Lions Eye Institute, Lung Institute of WA, The Heart Research Institute, Centre for Nursing Research and the Keogh Institute.

The Perkins Institute campus will house 500 people and will accommodate 750 researcher when at full capacity.

The design of the Institute, the layout of the offices, laboratories and social spaces will foster interaction between researcher from different disciplines and enable and encourage sharing of ideas and enthusiasm.

Great things will happen here.
