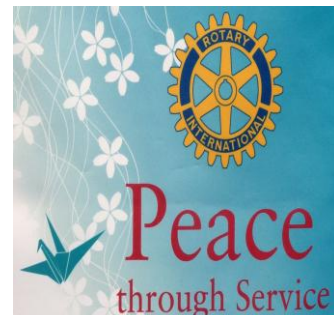

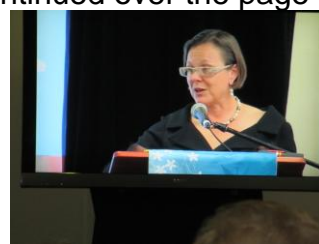
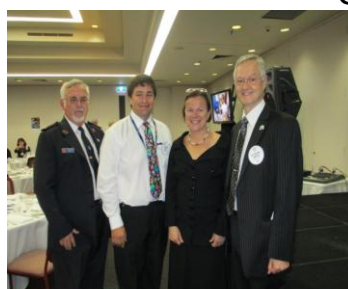

SCARLESS HEALING AND EVENING WITH PROFESSOR FIONA WOOD

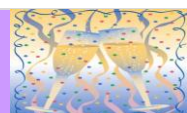
On 12th October, 2012, the 10th anniversary of the Bali Bombings, over 230 Bunbury Rotarians from all three clubs, partners, members of the Bunbury Chamber of Commerce and Industry and members of the public were privileged to host a commemorative evening with special guest Professor Fiona Wood. Professor Wood, the Director of Burns Service at Royal Perth Hospital, co-ordinated the management of the wounds of many victims of the bombing a decade ago. Earlier in the day she had given a lunch time key note address in Canberra and returned to WA in time to enrich our evening in Bunbury.

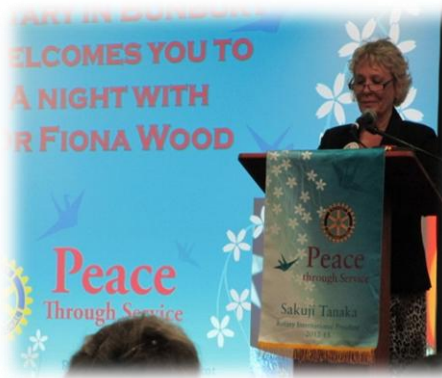


WEEKLY RAFFLE

MORE ABOUT PROFESSOR FIONA WOOD

The Bali Anniversary meeting was opened by President Stephen , who called for a minute silence in memory of those killed in the Bali Bombings. Trevor Wilson lead us in prayer for those killed, maimed and in mourning from the bombings and Turk Ellis lead a resounding National Anthem.



PP Glenys McDonald introduced Professor Fiona, who was born in the Yorkshire, UK, in 1958 and came to Australia in 1987. Professor Wood is a Plastic Surgeon and world leader in the management of burns and in research into burn wound management.

Her skills in disaster team management were demonstrated in the aftermath of the Bali bombings when large numbers of burn victims were transported to Royal Perth Hospital for treatment.

Prof Wood kept us captivated and enlightened us with a blend of biographic information, historical background, basic and medical science, psychology and innovative speculation. She even managed to fit in a burns first aid 101- Firstly remove clothes, cool the burnt area with cool clean water at 15 to 18 degrees for 20 minutes or until medical help arrives. That simple intervention could save thousands of health dollars.

In what has obviously become her trademark personality Fiona acknowledged the many members of her medical team that have helped in other major traumas, courage of individual victims, and other key contributors that enabled further research in the burns management. She concluded by highlighting the way forward. She believes strongly in the power of numbers of positively energized people who are committed to the one direction forward, this includes each and every one of us

taking responsibility for our own health and well being. It was an inspirational address.

President Stephen thanked Professor Fiona and gifted her with a Paul Harris Fellowship for energetic service to humanity. She received a standing ovation from the floor.

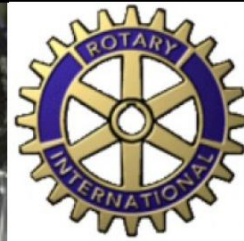
