BOARD MEETING REPORT

President Jim Stephen reported that the Board had agreed to a request from The Sean Thomas Pollard Trust for permission to collect donations from the public under the license issued to Rotary Club of South Bunbury Inc.

The use of the Club license by the Trust allows them to satisfy requirements of the Department of Commerce that donations will be used for the purpose of supporting the beneficiary.

The decision was made after a meeting attended by the settlor of the trust, the Trust's solicitor and Rotary Club of South Bunbury Board members.

CHRISTMAS LIGHTS

Dunstan Street Christmas lights display attracts up to 3000 visitors each evening during the week before Christmas. The Bunbury City Council requires and co-ordinates a traffic management plan. Volunteers are needed to perform these tasks and in doing so will attract funds for the Club.



LEARN ABOUT ROTARY

The Classification Principle

Virtually all membership in Rotary is based upon a "classification." A classification describes the recognized business or professional service that the Rotarian renders to society. Classifications are determined by activities or services to society rather than by the position held by a particular individual. It is the principal and recognized activity of a business or professional establishment or the individual's principal and recognized business or professional activity that determines the classification to be established and loaned to a qualified person.

The classification principle is a necessary concept in assuring that each Rotary club represents a cross section of the business and professional service of the community.

In 1995 the Council on Legislation permitted the admission of retired people who had never been in Rotary but would have been qualified. These individuals can be admitted as past service members and are the only Rotarians without a current or former classification.
