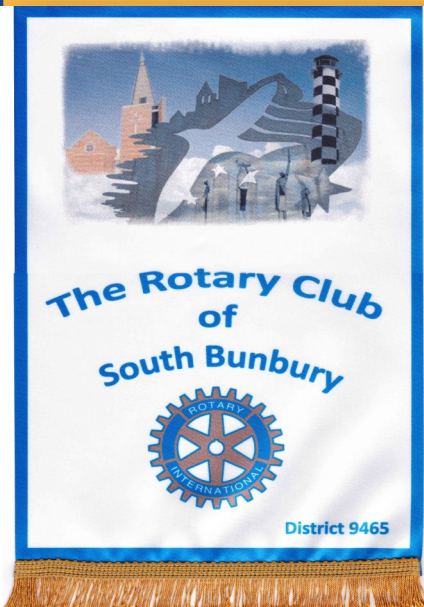

## EXERCISE PRUDENCE

Prudence can be defined as - doing the right thing, the right way, at the right time.

Brian Castieau was guest speaker at the morning meeting on 29th October. He shared with us some insights he has gained in his vocation as a financial planner and offered advice that is useful in life.

Plan carefully, not emotionally. Seek good advice as often there is help and dollars are available that are not even sought by those who don't know that its there.

Consider the time, days, weeks or even months, that you will spend working to pay for an extravagant purchase, don't only think of the dollar cost.

Brian explained the importance of locking in a level premium insurance at age 28 years as a way of reducing the long term cost of insurance. Good advice to pass on to our children.

On taxation, Brian quoted Benjamin Franklin saying "If those taxes laid on by the government were the only ones we had to pay we might more easily discharge them; but we have many others, and much more grievous to some of us. We are taxed twice as much by or idleness, three times as much by our pride, and four times as much by our folly; and from these taxes the commissioners cannot ease or deliver us, by allowing and abatement."

It was a good breakfast to start the day, served with a dose of wisdom.

### 2014 sets a record for The Rotary Foundation

- 27,689 clubs (approximately 80 percent of all Rotary clubs) contributed to the Annual Fund
- 367,629 individual Rotarians (30 percent of Rotary's membership) contributed to the Annual Fund
- In its first year as an official recognition program of The Rotary Foundation, the Paul Harris Society identified 10,143 members (each contributing \$1,000 each year).
