

GEARS GADGETS AND WIDGETS

With nearly 50 participants ,Clayton Hyden (founder's son) and Rodney Fox conducted two tours of the factory. Initially, it was a tin shed about 17 x 40 metres, now it is 1000s of square metres.





First part of the tour involved the original old part of the shed. This contained about 60 of the older machines which are still in use. The second new part of the factory was automated and members watched as clever little robots moved the heavy gear and gadgets from various section of the processing trail.







Next stop was The Intregres 400II that has a robotic arm that members were keen to view through the special window. Finally, the tour ended in the heat treated plant where we viewed a product coming out of the 800 degree furniss. It was bright red – see picture on the front page! Tour concluded with some words from Clayton on the valued added aspect of the business and its ability to stay at the forefront of the industry whilst still keeping jobs and serving business' in Australia.
