What are our troops doing in Afghanistan?

Nola Marino, MHR, gave a most informative and entertaining rendition about her recent parliamentary trip to Afghanistan. She explained what our troops, and others, are doing in Afghanistan. Glenys McDonald introduced Nola, who is a born and bred Brunswick girl, with a history in dairy farming and things mechanical. Our troops were deployed to Afghanistan to mentor the Afghanistan National Army and police force. They are changed with the task of restoring core services and civil rights to the Afghanistan people. Most of Australia's work takes place in Uruzgan province, where our troops have been responsible for building wells, bridges, roads, schools, providing education and drought relief and demining some 132 328 square metres of contaminated land so that the locals can return to growing vegetables and crops. We can be proud of our men and women. Nola had some profound experiences to share which generated a great deal of interest from members, but an important message was that this support and interest will be needed when our men and women return home. Nola was thanked for an excellent talk by Andy.
