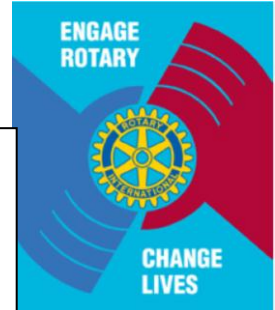

She stopped her PhD studies, sold her home, and went to work with the lost, the least, and the last.

Harriet enjoined us to smile and keep her happy at our club meetings which have a grounding effect for her.

In response to a question about the crisis accommodation home built by Rotary, Harriet mentioned that, given safety requirements for such a home to have 2 exits, and the house having only one, it is currently not in use. (any volunteers to add in an external door?)

Peter Hill informed us that for the Children's fair in 2015, there will be horse rides available, courtesy of the Riding for the disabled group.

Dr Zaki Dorkham updated us about the two lifts installed in a home for the aged in Lebanon, to which our club contributed \$2,000, and matching grants assisted in \$50,000 being funded.

This year, there are two international projects we are invited to participate in:

1. Purchasing urolog equipment for use in Madagascar via Dr Sue Chapman of Bunbury and Australian Doctors for Africa. And
2. A project to supply drinking water to 300 primary schools in Lebanon. The Club has committed \$2,000 to this project; other clubs are committing, and global grants will be sought.
