Fired Up About Science

This week's speaker was Patrick Ryan, an articulate student from Newton Moore Senior High School. Patrick was sponsored by SBRC to attend a twelve day National Youth Science Forum which Patrick described as 'life changing'. He gave a brief account of the experience which included long days of both academic and social activities that were challenging and motivating. Some of the more academic experiences that stood out for Patrick were the trip to Fremantle, where the curators took them behind the public scenes to view artefacts from shipwrecks over 250 years ago; Future of the Country talk; Mock congress, where law and science were involved; Robotics at Murdoch University, environmental engineering at UWA and Stirling Naval base. He also met some amazing people such as a scientist resembling Einstein, who taught him that 'you don't have to have money to lead an extraordinary life' and discussions with fighter pilots from WWII. Patrick felt that this experience had given him a second family and had played a major role in his career path, which will now be in environmental science.
