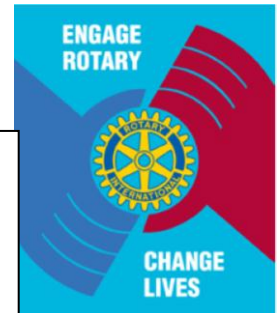

### **Children's Fair**

Gerald Shaw, President of the South West Model Engineers Association presented a cheque for \$1,350 to the Club being the proceeds of the train rides from the Children's Fair.

Our Club donated proceeds from the Children's Fair to the three recipient charities (see photos on next page).

Riding for the disabled: Pat Brown, President, thanked the Club and said the funds would be used to help fund a sick bay, subsidise needy riders, and generally promote hippotherapy.

Sail into Life: Sharon Kavangah thanked the Club and said funds would be used to help fund a heavy duty rescue boat.

Teach, Learn, Grow (TLG). CEO Louise Wing was the guest speaker and said the funds would be used to help send 10 tutors to schools in the area. Other points she mentioned included:

- TLG now focuses on numeracy, literacy no being amenable to the nature of the program
- 180 tutors are sent out at a time, 400 having applied.
- Follow-up assistance with a homework session is done via Skype 6 months later
