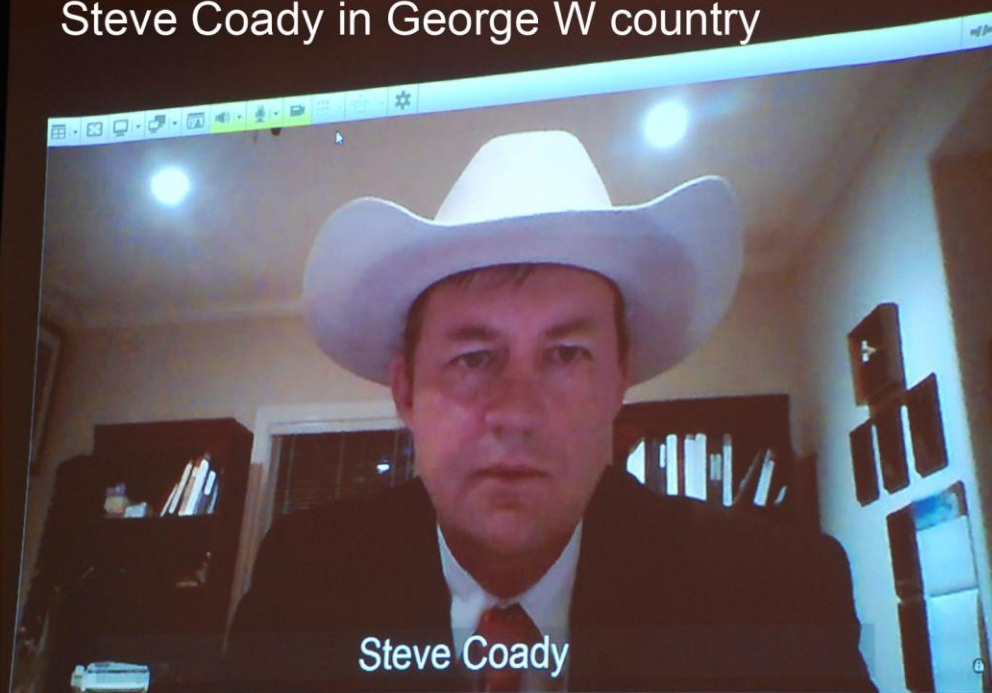
Urgent plea
