Sailing in the Mediterranean to Spain and

Portugal and then to Gibraltar was good test. 35k headwinds, gusting to 50k and high waves proved to be a test of crew and boat as the boat has to be manned 24/7. Despite the seasickness and everything the Mediterranean waters threw at him he looks amazingly fit and tanned and is still our Kev. Well done mate.
