Julie Palmer of the South West Catchment Council gave an interesting and informative presentation on the proposed Preston River to Ocean Regional Park Project. The project involves conservation of a 7 km bushland corridor containing four major vegetation complexes of our Swan Coastal Plain. Priority will be given to weed control, dune rehabilitation, garbage clearing, pest control and containment of dieback. Community volunteering opportunities are a component of the proposed solution.
