National Youth Busking Challenge

Buskers Guidelines

- 1. The Busker must collect their Busker number from Allison Music, 85 Forsyth Street Wagga on Thursday or Friday March 14 & 15. If there is difficulty in the collection, Saturday morning will be OK. The number will notify the Busker of the allotted site
- 2. There will be no power supplied to any site.
- 3. The sites will be allocated and drawn by lot
- 4. Buskers must stay within their allocated lot
- 5. Each Busker is allocated a maximum of 20 minutes which includes the setting up and closing down time.
- 6. Buskers must contain noise level so as to not annoy shopkeepers, shoppers or other buskers.
- 7. Groups are limited to 4 persons
- 8. Buskers must perform in their own age bracket. If they are in a group they must perform in the group of the oldest member of the group
- 9. The age groups are under 10, 10 to under 14, and 14 to under 18. Date of birth ID required at time of collecting busking number. The applicable date will be 16 March 2019 .E.g. If a Busker turns 10 on 24 March they will be required to perform in the 10 to under 14 category.
- 10. Winners and runners-up announcement and presentation is at Allison Music

a. Under10 Midday
b. 10 to under 14 1 pm
c. 14 to under 18 2.30 pm

- 11. All Buskers are admitted free to the Food & Wine Festival. There is also free admittance for any person under 18
- 12. Winners are invited to perform at the Food & Wine Festival on Saturday March 23. The following times will apply
 - a. Under 10 performing at 4 pm for max of 5 minutes
 - b. 10 to under 14 performing at 5.30 pm for max of 5 minutes
 - c. 14 to under 18 performing at 7.30 pm for max of 7 minutes
- 13. The winners who perform at the Festival will be introduced to a Rotarian who will coordinate with that winner. That is Darren Wallace phone 0409 120 108. Please ring Darren when you get to the Festival at least 30 minutes before your performance time
- 14. Prize money is paid to the nominated bank account of winners and runner up. Those details will be collected on the date of the event.
- 15. There is no entry fee on registration.
- 16. All registrations are to be made online. Closing date is Wednesday March 14

- 18. Money given by spectators may be retained by Buskers
- 19. Judges decision will be final
