John Ferguson introduced our guest speaker, Rugby league legend Phil Jackson. John said "Phil was known as the 'Prince of Centres'" John noted that Phil is in the Wagga Rugby Men's Choir and it was a pleasure to sing with him. John has known Phil since the 60's. Phil moved to Wagga and John struck up a friendship with him when Phil was a Publican. John said that Phil is one of the lead bases in the choir. John noted that Phil toured Australia with 3 Great Britain Teams in the 50's and was Captain of one of them.

Phil started by thanking John and said he always felt at home in Rotary. Phil has been a member of Wagga Wagga Rotary for over 30 years. He also said he recognized several members of the Wagga Rugby Choir in the room and was especially grateful for the POME meal of fish and chips for lunch and that he had a "Nelson" sitting next to him.. Phil has lived in Australia for over 50 years but the minute he opens his mouth everyone knows that he is a POME.

He takes particular pride in being from England, especially being part of a winning team. In the 1950's he was offered 800 pounds to play professionally with Barrow-in-Furness. He played in Wembley for the Challenge Cup which he noted was more important than the Premier Cup. He was selected to be a part of the 1954 tour of Australia. As soon as he got here, he thought "how long has this been going on". He walked down to the Cricket Grounds with

2. Encourage and assist selected youth leaders and potential leaders in methods of responsible and effective youth leadership by providing them with a training experience
3. Publicly recognise the high qualities of many young people who are rendering service to their communities as youth leaders.
