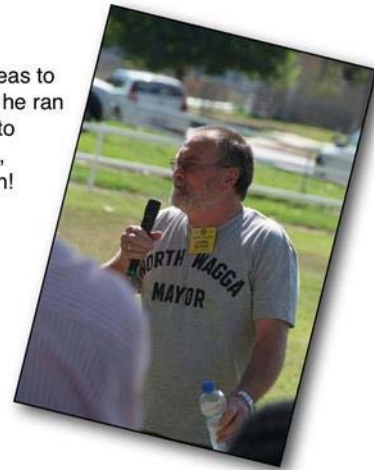

**Guest Speaker.** Graham Gorrel spoke on his experience in the newspaper industry both here and in Australia. He has had a very interesting career and rubbed shoulders with many of the movers and shakers in the late seventies and early eighties in London. He left Australia to look for further opportunities in London after working for The Daily Liberal in Dubbo for a few years.

He claims he got his first London job because of the Rotary connection.

He was working in the times of Edward Heath and Margaret Thatcher, and at the height of the IRA raids in London.

One personality he spoke fondly of was Neave who eventually became the Opposition spokesman on Northern Ireland. This man was largely instrumental in getting Margaret Thatcher's career going and was assassinated by an IRA bomb in Westminster before he could fulfill his true potential.

Graham had the meeting in the palm of his hand, but the time ran out all too soon.

He was thanked by Allan Eldridge.
