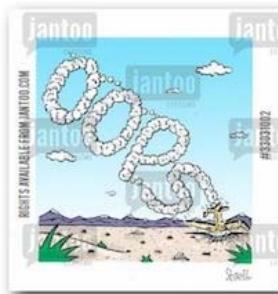
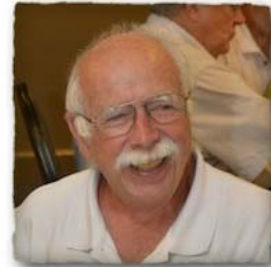
### Today is a Hillis Day, so there was no guest speaker.

**Rotary Information** was given by PP Peter Crozier. Rotarians in Australia continue to recognise the motto **SERVICE ABOVE SELF** through the awarding of a Paul Harris Fellowship. It does not necessarily have to be awarded to a Rotarian but is generally so. It is possible to purchase a Paul Harris Fellowship at a cost of US \$1000 which does not have to be an award. Wollundry is able to be eligible for the awarding of Paul Harris Fellowships by means of its contributions to the Rotary Foundation. That is where the sergeant's fines are directed to. Today Rotary International has a membership of 1,228 million in around 34,340 clubs in 215 countries. Rotary encourages diversity in membership that includes a mix of vocations, ethnic backgrounds, age and genders in most clubs.

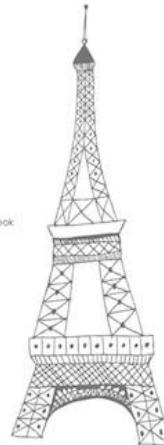
