President Phil gave a comprehensive report from last week's Board Meeting. This included a treasurer's report from Peter MacKinnon which gave the club a combined balance of approximately \$130,000 in the four accounts of Club, Community, Reserve and Food & Wine Festival. Phil emphasised that some monies for club dues are yet to be paid to Rotary International and District.

There was an expansive and thorough report from the Sunday Markets committee headed by Col Mercer.

It was agreed by the meeting to endorse the Board's decision to continue to published the weekly bulletin in the public domain of the website. Membership of the club is currently 79 with one new application, and our exchange student, Nelson Alvarado.

During the course of President Phil's welcome four projects were carried by the members for funding:

- St Vincent de Paul-a donation of \$1,740 for Rotary overnight kits and blankets for the homeless.
- Polio Plus-a donation of \$1,500.
- Little Big Day Out- a refund of the hire fee for the tents of \$750
- Philippines Cyclone Disaster- a donation of \$4,000 to provide 4 shelter boxes. This could be expanded on an application of the Projects Committee to the Board.



Past President, Andrew Irvine announced that the interest received from the club's bank accounts for 2012-13 will be donated to the Ashmont Churches Schools Breakfast Programs.
