## Rotary Information

Doug Sutton gave an excellent presentation that all Rotarians should take special interest in. The presentation was a summary of an address to the 2011 Rotaract Meeting in New Orleans by David Postic entitled "*Why we don't want Rotary to be like Baseball.*"



The summary likened the game of Baseball to Rotary. Historically Baseball is called the American's Pastime, yet few Americans watch the games because the game can be slow, boring, and it can get old very quickly. Similarly, there are many younger people who love the idea of Rotary, but when you look at some Rotary clubs they appear to be slow and boring.

Rotary as we know can change the world, look at the result of eradicating polio. This is a powerful message and it is one young people need to hear. Younger people choose not to join existing clubs as they see them as a retirement home, and form new clubs. This is not a bad thing but history tells us that older clubs struggle for members and eventual may have to go into recess.

David Postic suggests Rotary clubs need to encourage younger people to join by developing innovative projects that really make a difference. Secondly he encourages clubs to give new members responsibilities, listen to their ideas and involve the club in change. He concluded with his comparison of Rotary to Baseball, and as long as the two institutions are seen to be slow and boring what reason do new and younger people need to join.
