Nelson gave us a brief talk on his travels and experiences. He is having a great time and settling in so well to Wagga.

An update on the floods in Canmore came from **Brett Pickard**, via I think, Kevin Watts. They are fine, as is his mother, but the devastation is very great. This is his edited email.



"Hello Everyone -

The damage in Canmore was significant with wash outs to the Trans Canada Highway and the Canadian Pacific Railway (main line) having the effect of cutting the town off from Calgary and Banff for about three days. We were on a boil water alert for 2 weeks. Damage to Calgary's infrastructure, businesses and homes is very severe. High River town with around 12,000

souls was totally evacuated and many people are just returning to their homes - several of which will not be habitable - if they are still standing.

The costs for recovery have been estimated at 5 billion - and it will take several months/years to complete. Our Canmore Rotary Charitable Foundation received donations in the range of \$225,000 in just over 10 days.

Fortunately our family did not sustain any substantial damage and today the sun is shining!!"

Rotary Information. Did you know that RI now accepts that if you are travelling overseas, the 14 day requirement for makeups is dropped. This mean that if you are away overseas longer than 14 days, you can do a makeup(s) before you leave which will cover your abscence.

Once a club of less than ten had to pay RI the full dues of ten persons. That has been rescinded and now a club simply pays the dues of its members, be that 5 or 55!

The 85 rule previously was calculated by adding your age of 65, then adding the number of your years in Rotary to reach 85. There is no longer a requirement to have reached 65, but your age plus years of service still needs to total 85.

Australian Rotary Health

Rotary has many many programmes, a great number of which are International.

This is one that is Australian, home grown, and the benefits stay in Australia.

Australian Rotary Health provides funds that that are spent in Australia on Research and Medical Scholarships to improve the health firstly of Australians and thence to the wider world.

Our Indigenous Scholarships are aimed at helping medical students to obtain the qualifications they need. It is an unfortunate fact that our indigenous people have worse health outcomes than the rest of the Australian community. Indigenous Health Scholarships go a long way to addressing this unacceptable situation.

While there is an emphasis on Mental Health, the research scope is much wider. For example, one supported PhD Scholarship is looking at a vaccine for melanoma. This is particularly exciting as the vaccine actually works, but only for a limited time. Our PhD student is trying to find out why.

The research is exciting, and the results could well be life changing.

Australian Rotary Health is at the forefront of Health Research and is the largest non-government supplier of research funds into mental health in Australia.
