Our Guest Speaker.



Today we had one of our newer members, **Wayne Jenkins**, talking on the emissions from internal combustion engines and how practices have changed in recent times.

Petrol and diesel engines all produce Nitrous Oxides, which are both irritants and carcinogenic.

Introduced by a fellow Marrar lad, **David Hodge**, Wayne had a very attentive audience.

Among some of the interesting facts was that petrol is only 5% efficient, yet is likely to be the fuel of

the future because of its convenience.

Wayne went on to explain that engines have been engineered as far as it is possible to

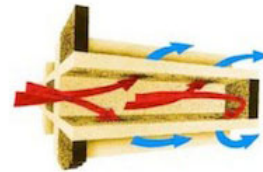
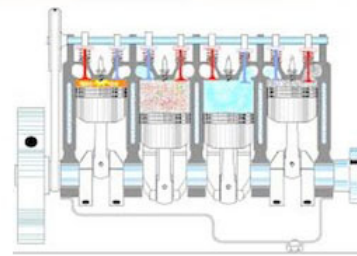
reduce the emissions. Now, he pointed out, the efforts at reducing escaping gases are concentrating on after, external treatments.

Catalytic Converters and Particulate Filters are being widely used. We are even injecting urine (urea) into the system to break down the nasties. Reintroducing exhaust gases to the intake to lower the operating temperature of the motor, and computer adjusted turbocharging are all playing their part.

Agricultural users are redirecting exhaust gases to the soil to make use of the Nitrogen

and some urea. It is interesting that CO₂ is one of the non-toxic gases sought, along with Nitrogen, Water and Oxygen.

This was a very detailed talk with great graphs, movies and diagrammes that all served to clearly explain an other wise complex and baffling subject. But we still have more to hear and Wayne will bring back Part 2 very soon. **PP Michael Knight** gave the vote of thanks.
