This document is designed to help us determine what projects we may want to support as a club. The projects may be local or international. The form can either be filled out by you or you may pass it on to an organization that you feel may benefit from our clubs support. Ideally if every Rotarian could bring in a completed form, this exercise would have a broad range of potential projects to choose from. Once all the sheets have been compiled we will use the process of "Dot-mocracy" (eg Assessment forms will be hung on a wall and each Rotarian will be given a number of dots, which will then be placed on the assessments they choose) to identify which projects to support. This process of Dot-mocracy" will takes 2 stages, first an initial stage to narrow down the project suggestion to a few choices. Then the selected projects will be returned to applicants with a request for more detail, possibly having them have a short presentation with our club, followed by final selection.
