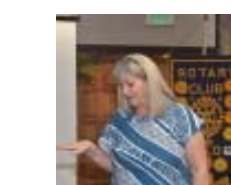
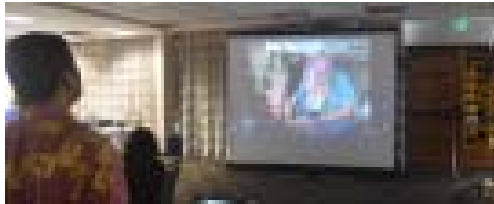


Stew Hussey was acknowledged as earning his **Paul Harris Fellowship+8 Award**. It was an honor to have **Stew's**
