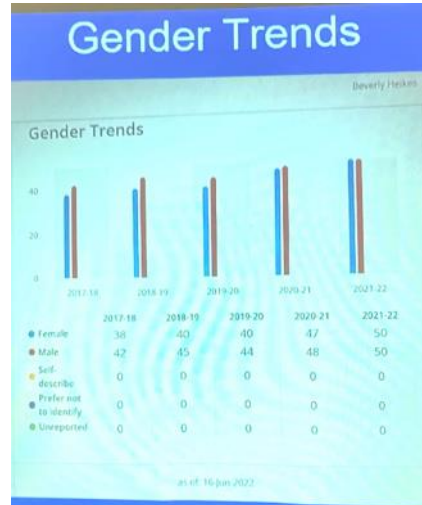
President **Beverly Heikes** recognized our new upcoming President, **Connie Ichinose**. **“We will be working hard this next year.”**
