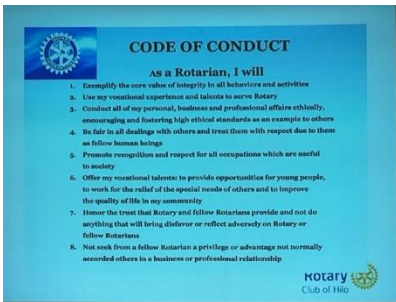
# Rotary Club of Hilo Lava Flow
