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




Greece Central School District Community Schools Update

Funding of Community

Supports ent of Education Funding

- From 25 million dollars in 2020 to 150 million in 2023, unsure future...
- Community Schools in NYS
 - o 900+ schools
- New York State
 - 250 million dollars in community schools set aside
 - 1.2 million dollars to (3) CS Technical Assistance Centers
- Other states:
 - O California 4.1 Billion
 - Maryland 369 million
 - o Florida 20 million




Community School Strategy

Integrated Systems of Support

District-wide Food Pantry (Arcadia Middle School)

- Additional "mini" pantries at Olympia, Athena, Longridge, Buckman Heights, and the Early Learning Center
- Almost **1,000 visits** to ARMS pantry this school year (consistent with 23/24 numbers)
- Partnerships with Greece Ecumenical, The Center 4 Hope, and Mission Share

Togetherlow

Community guides us. Connection drives us.

TogetherNow is focused on creating **strategic partnerships** and **communication** between organizations across the county. The goal is to create a **person-centered approach** to support the community using MyWayFinder.

GCSD is proud to be one of eight TogetherNow Neighborhood Navigation Centers in Monroe County

- Over 250 families have been referred to our NNC since August 2022
- Families also come to the NNC to:
 - Work on resumes
 - Apply for jobs and apartments
 - Receive guidance on applying for benefits
 - Better navigate services in the district
 - Donate/receive gently used clothing and household items
 - Create MyWayFinder accounts to connect to resources and services

Connections to Services







Our vision is to assist families in reaching their goals by providing access to services, support, and financial assistance to improve and maintain their overall well-being.

Focus Areas:

- Stable housing
- •Remove barriers to employment (lack of transportation, childcare, fingerprinting, medical exam, etc.)
- Person-centered services and support (Neighborhood Navigation Center)

Current Needs

Eviction Prevention:

- To qualify, families prove they can afford rent
- Most families with rental arrears are affected by extenuating circumstances

• Stable Housing:

 Security deposits often are a barrier to housing

Remove Barriers:

- Childcare expenses before receiving a first paycheck
- Equipment needed for work
- Vehicle repairs to maintain employment



May 2024 - Current Data

- 15 families accepted into the program
- \$24,582 spent
 - 4 families used funds for eviction prevention and/or mortgage assistance
 - 10 families used funds for a security deposit
 - 1 family used funds for childcare needs related to employment
 - 1 family used funds for a new refrigerator

^{*}Please note, some families were able to use funds for more than one purpose (i.e. partial security deposit and car payment)*



Evaluation Results

- Out of 32 participants that have been evaluated since the start of the program, 94% report having stable housing
- All surveyed recipients said they believe CCI funds helped stabilize their family
- Since our last presentation, 12 participants have completed two or more check ins in MyWayFinder and all 12 have reported improvements in two or more domains
- All surveyed CCI recipients say they would not change anything about how the program assisted their family
- New employee dedicated to CCI program and its success
- Future plans
- Enough funding left for 4-5 recipients





The Story of One Family

Amy recently left a negative relationship and became a single mom
of three boys. In an effort to keep stability for her kids, she started
working extra jobs to be able to keep up with the expenses of the
home they rent.

 Amy was behind on child care costs and rent, and at risk of losing both.

 The Neighborhood Navigation Center was able to identify the financial need and help Amy apply for the Child Care Subsidy to help with child care costs moving forward.



The Story of One Family (cont.)

- With assistance for child care approved and her upcoming increase in income, Amy was accepted into the CCI program. She received support that helped her get back on track with her rental and child care arrears, allowing her to maintain steady employment.
- Now, Amy is doing well. She's caught up on her bills, maintaining stable employment, and feeling more secure in her day-to-day life. She shares that she's incredibly grateful to have come across the Neighborhood Navigation Center and deeply appreciates all the support she received while going through a difficult time. The help she found there made a real difference during one of the toughest periods of her life.
