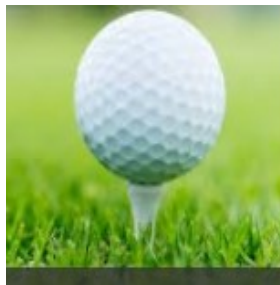

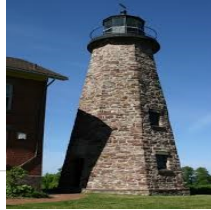

**Club Assembly Notes 04-16-18**

1. Membership Renewals will be out end of the month with a definite increase in District dues could go up at least \$4 person for maybe the next three years. We have an RI \$8.00 increase this year, so we are facing a \$12/increase this year.
2. The club voted to accept Rick Antelli's resignation letter
3. Kim's Installation dinner –June 1 –Lake Shore Country Club -\$30/head
4. Brick and Mortar Vote – The vote authorized the club to spend up to \$100,000 for the construction of the Rotary Lodge on Elmgrove/Ridgeway Dr. By a vote of 10-3. The emails I received were 31 –In Favor//6 –No's & 2 –Non Committals – or a 84% approval & 9 of the top 11 Ziti Sellers also approved of the project.
5. The Board voted to proceed the \$10,000 Special Needs Grant to the Villa of Hope for their student work based learning program for one year.

**Committee Reports**

- Membership –Meet and Greet Tomorrow night – I expect about 15-20 Greece potentials members at the event.
- Ziti – A few changes for next year –
  - Tables will have numbers on them – so you can find grandma
  - Kim needs a substitute Dining Room Chairperson –
  - Board Voted **–(Not Unwritten Anymore)** –that if you miss Ziti without an excused absence or a sub – you WILL be fined \$100.00- We are also reworking the Member Expectation's Process.
- Ziti \$\$\$\$ Numbers \$42,600-Budget Goal was \$43,000
- Public Image – Judie got some articles in the Grapevine and a full page ad for the Golf Outing. Tree Planting for all Rotarians – 1 per year –so we are planting for \$2/tree in the national forest in Minn.
- Foundation Report –We are over 130-150% for our 2018 goals
- Community Service – Greece Ecum Food Collection on May.
- Grants –Judie has four grants to review with her committee for the next board meeting.
- Literacy- DSG Grant for the Little Libraries submitted – club exp. \$2K
- International Committee – Kim/Dan working with the Puerto Rico Rotary district on a water/well project maybe two – more to follow on \$\$
- Vocational/Youth Service – Meeting after today's meeting with Tracey and Melissa to review the submittals
- Exchange Student – Mike Taylor he is recommending a girl from France as our exchange student next year- excellent student & accomplished roller skater.
- The Board voted to buy Two NEW Rotary Road signs for the Ridge Rd/Home Depot location –it is ripped off the post, and Elmgrove Rd.-(Brad Turners old home)- this sign is very faded.
