The COVID pandemic continued to impact many of our projects. Some were put on hold and others were modified to meet CDC and the Monroe County Health Department guidelines and protocols.



## **FINANCIAL REPORT**

The Foundation's starting balance for the year was \$7,858.

During the year \$11,700 was generated from donations and fundraisers.

\$10,740 was expended on the 2021-2022 Club projects.

The foundation ended the year with a fund balance of \$8,818.
