LITERACY PROJECTS: Recognizing the important role literacy plays in improving lives and empowering people, the Rochester Latino Rotary Club is committed to supporting universal literacy and education initiatives.



RLRC College Scholarship Recipients: The RLRC awarded two college scholarships to graduates of the EMHCS who demonstrated service above self.

Parents as Reading Partners-Kindergarten Project: Rotarians read the book to the students. Students learned about the value of trees. Students collected \$100 to donate to OneTreePlanted. The RLRC matched the students' donations. A total of \$200 was donated to OneTreePlanted.

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS: To provide services to our community and people in need.
