As a service project the students collected \$50 through a penny challenge campaign. The RLRC matched the \$50 and sent a check for a total of \$100 to the Amazon Watch Organization.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The Foundation's starting balance for the year was \$10,153.24.

During the year \$860 was generated from donations and returned checks for pandemic related cancelled events.

\$3,480.86 was expended on the 2020-2021 Club projects.

The foundation ended the year with a fund balance of \$7,804.38.
