The Facts

- Australia's disabled care is falling behind and would benefit enormously.
- Currently no structured program allowing pwd (Person with Disability) to move away from home.
- 7000+ young pwd living in age care facilities.
- 45% of pwd are living on or below the OECD poverty line.
- By 2020 around 120,000 pwd will be in need of some form of housing.
- NDIS, Australian disability services will become national rather than state based: currently \$11 billion per year to \$22 billion per year by 2020.
- By 2020 the NDIS will be supporting 470,000 pwd.
- Vital that we seize this opportunity to take action and become ambassadors to improve the standard of living.




You replace the traditional house design with a Greenhouse made for living in?








Greenhouse food production...
